



REPORT ON THE 1St BIOGAS CHINA FORUM

The ASIA PACIFIC BIOGAS ALLIANCE (APBA), INTERNATIONAL CLEAN ENERGY & SUSTAINABILITY NETWORK (ICESN) and the BIOGAS INSTITUTE OF MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (BIOMA), collaborated for the first time in the organization of the BIOGAS CHINA FORUM on the 8 – 9 September 2016 at the Fulo Hotel in Chengdu, China.

Over 180 people attended the 2-day conference, with over 22 papers presented, giving greater insight into developments in China, and countries in South East Asia, as well as promoting greater cooperation between China and South East Asia's Biogas Markets.

Dupont sponsored the conference, taking the opportunity to introduce their new enzyme for the biogas market. Using the enzyme during the biogas digestion process will boost biogas yields by as much as 15% while reducing operating costs by 10%. Their presentation generated a lot of interest and we are very interested to see the results from application of Dupont's enzymes in South East Asia and China.
